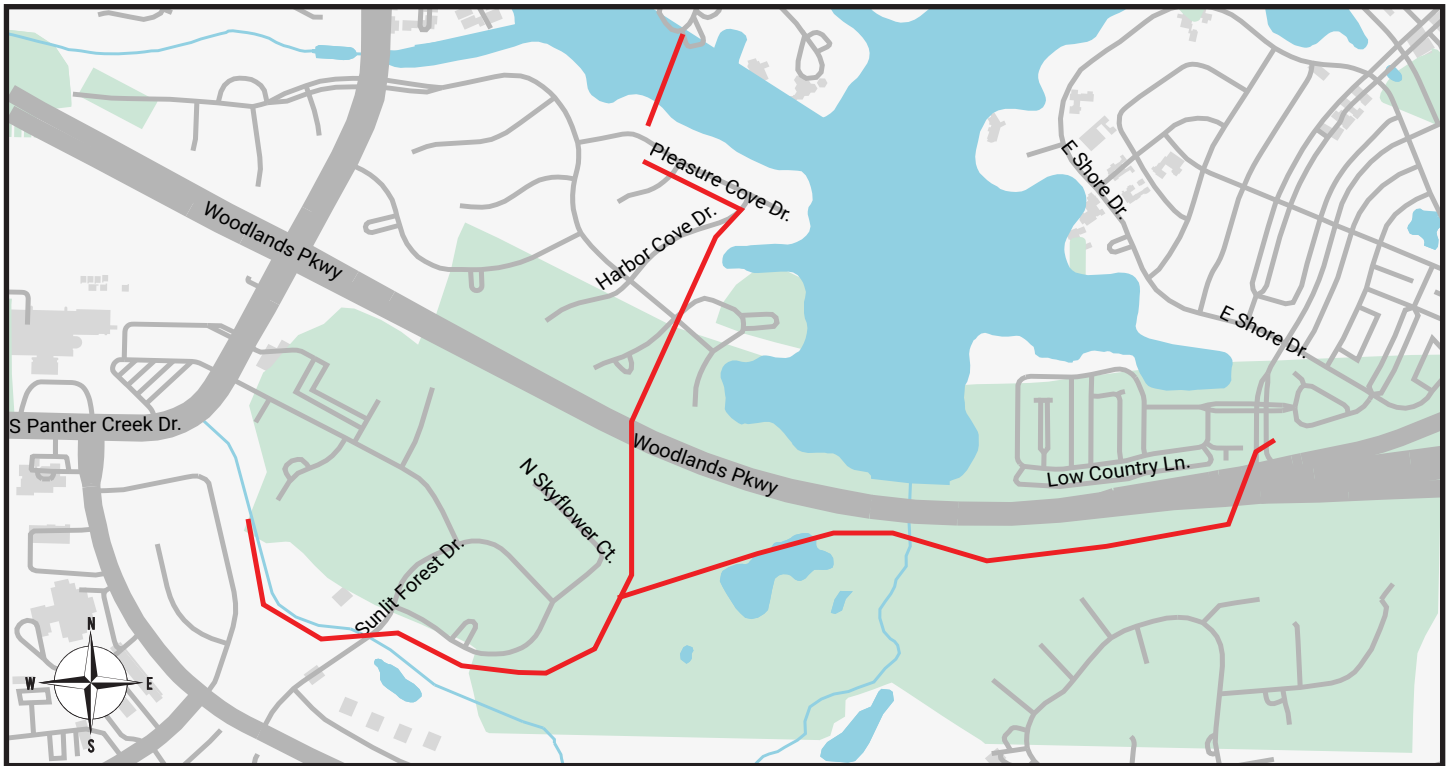

Project History

Some wastewater lines in The Woodlands' system have been in operation for over 40 years and are approaching their useful service life, making them vulnerable to failure, sewage overflows, and permit violations. San Jacinto River Authority (SJRA) Asset Management Program and the Sanitary Sewer Transmission Assessment and Renewal (SSTAR) Program identified high-risk line segments in 2019-2020 through Closed Circuit Television Video (CTTV) inspection, revealing significant deterioration in gravity mains.

Description

This project rehabilitates or replaces 1.8 miles of ductile iron (DI) gravity mains as part of a phased approach to strengthen wastewater infrastructure resilience.
